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#### **Executive Summary**

The purpose of the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC) is to promote efficient professional healthcare licensing and professional technical licensing in the State of New Hampshire. Pursuant to RSA 310-A, in FY21 OPLC oversaw the administration of forty-seven occupational licensing boards; these Boards, Councils, and Commissions directly regulate their professions pursuant to the powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities granted to them by individual practice acts. OPLC provides administrative, clerical, business processing and recordkeeping support to these Boards, Councils, and Commissions to assist in carrying out all statutory objectives in an efficient manner.

In addition, in FY21, OPLC directly regulated four professions, with the advice of advisory boards. OPLC had sole regulatory authority over one profession. To promote workforce opportunities in the State by increasing the interstate mobility of licensed professionals, in FY21 OPLC was authorized to issue temporary and emergency licenses to individuals licensed in other jurisdictions. In FY21, OPLC undertook several initiatives to meet its statutory objective of achieving efficient operations. These initiatives are detailed below.

#### **OPLC Restructuring**

In FY21, OPLC continued its restructuring initiative developed in FY20. The plan called for restructuring agency personnel based on job function in lieu of subject matter. OPLC sought necessary statutory changes in HB2 to create the Division of Licensing and Board Administration and Division of Enforcement. In FY21, OPLC's restructuring efforts paved the way to streamline processes and establish efficiencies in process. OPLC anticipates completing its restructuring in FY22.

#### Creation of Enforcement Unit

An initial phase in OPLC's FY21 restructuring included establishing an Enforcement Unit. Staff with enforcement-related responsibilities were grouped together on the first floor of 7 Eagle Square, under a centralized management structure. Enforcement Staff collaborated with many boards to acquire legal authority to streamline OPLC's complaint intake process so that the agency could provide better support. Working together, the boards and the agency created one complaint process for the large majority of the boards under OPLC. This significantly reduced the timeframe for complaints to be processed and permitted accurate tracking.

#### **Customer Support**

In FY21, OPLC determined that housing customer service with individual license clerks created single sources of failure, and significantly disrupted licensing staff from being able to timely and efficiently issue licenses. Accordingly, in March 2021, OPLC launched a customer service unit to consolidate the customer service experience and ensure that no call is left unanswered. At the conclusion of FY21, the Customer Service Unit (CSU) was fielding all customer service inquiries to the OPLC. OPLC averages 500 calls per day. With

the addition of new software, OPLC is now able to track the purpose of each call and respond proactively to reduce call volume and increase communications with licensees.

#### **Hearings Examiner**

Another area of opportunity for improvement that OPLC identified in FY21 was a need for an attorney to assist the boards in drafting legal decisions and orders, at a bare minimum. In November 2020, OPLC hired an attorney to function as a Hearings Examiner. By the end of FY21, the majority of boards were utilizing the hearings examiner to assist with drafting legal orders, providing legal advice, and presiding over hearings. Rather than orders taking months to be released to the parties, the hearings examiner was able to draft decisions in a two-week timeframe.

#### DOJ/OPLC Collaboration (Client Counseling and Enforcement)

In FY21, OPLC worked with the Department of Justice (DOJ) to determine a way to improve legal support all boards, councils, and commissions within the agency. Historically, DOJ provided two forms of support to OPLC and the boards, councils, and commissions within the agency— (1) client counseling from attorneys through the Civil Bureau; and (2) assistance with investigations and prosecutions through the Administrative Prosecutions Unit in the Consumer Bureau. Due to OPLC's restructuring, in FY21, OPLC was able to provide legal support in-house. Accordingly, OPLC and DOJ shifted the approach to client counseling and enforcement to ensure the agencies optimal, efficient legal support to all boards, councils, and commissions.

Beginning April 1, 2021, the agencies provided all boards, councils, and commissions with an attorney or member of senior leadership to attend all meetings for the entire meeting. OPLC continued to provide initial assistance for legal questions arising between meetings; For questions that required additional support, OPLC coordinated with DOJ for legal assistance.

Regarding enforcement activities and support, OPLC and DOJ concluded that DOJ's front-line support for enforcement activities was no longer needed. State agencies typically handle their own enforcement activities and utilize DOJ for backup, as needed. Given the OPLC's reorganization, the agencies reached an agreement to dissolve the Administrative Prosecutions Unit as of July 1, 2021. Beginning in FY22, and with the passing of HB2, the Division of Enforcement within OPLC will handle enforcement cases. In FY22 and FY23, OPLC will fully fund three positions at DOJ for dedicated legal support in the Civil Bureau and Consumer Bureau. It is anticipated that the Consumer Bureau will be able to handle more unlicensed practice and provide legal support to investigators and prosecutors.

#### **Key Legislation**

OPLC and the Boards were very active during the FY21 legislative session. Pertinent OPLC-requested bills included SB58 (enacted); certain provisions of SB133 (enacted); and, SB13 (laid on the table). Other legislation significantly impacting OPLC and/or the boards included: HB70, HB94, HB143, HB567, HB572, SB45, and SB57. In FY21, OPLC obtained software to assist the agency with bill tracking and to provide boards with updates.

#### Continued COVID-19 Response

OPLC worked diligently throughout FY21 to timely license individuals to assist with the State's COVID-19 response. Among other things, OPLC issued thousands of emergency licenses, typically in 24 business hours from receipt of completed application. When the State of Emergency ended, OPLC promulgated an emergency rule to convert all emergency licenses to a temporary license, to avoid disruptions in continuity of care. For additional emergency licensing statistics, see Appendix D.

#### OPLC Physical Relocation and Office Expansion

In FY21, OPLC vacated the Anna Philbrook Building so that the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) could convert the building to transitional housing. There was no appropriate state-owned building available and, at the time, the only commercial space that was available within a very short timeframe was 7 Eagle Square in Concord, New Hampshire. OPLC entered into a ten-year lease for the first, second, and third floors of 7 Eagle Square, which was approved by Governor and Council on August 5, 2020.

Notably, the 16,247 square feet of space acquired by OPLC in August 2020 was an approximate 40% decrease in space that OPLC occupied at the Anna Philbrook Building in FY20. Following OPLC's physical relocation, OPLC increased staff members (including embedded IT support and licensing staff). The boards returned to in-person meetings on May 7, 2021. Modifications were made to support social distancing. As such, OPLC quickly outgrew its space at 7 Eagle Square. At the close of FY21, OPLC sought to obtain additional office space located on the fourth floor of 7 Eagle Square. OPLC's lease amendment was approved in FY22.

#### Information Technology

In FY21, OPLC added two additional positions to its Information Technology unit. With a staffing compliment of two Business Systems Analysts and an Information Technology Manager, the OPLC was able to initiate many IT initiatives with a primary focus on improving stakeholder and customer experiences. In addition, these resources were able to enhance collaborative partnerships with NH Department of Information Technology for better access to the shared technical resources required for many of the goals and objectives represented in the OPLC Advanced Information Technology Plan (AITP).

#### **OPLC** on the World Wide Web

Through the OPLC reorganization efforts, the OPLC was challenged with creating a single organizational identity online while providing access to fifty plus professional boards. Development of the new OPLC website began in October 2020 and launched in January 2021. The new OPLC site design and standards provide a consistent look and feel with easy access to Board information, licensure resources, laws and rules and other Board appropriate online resources under a single OPLC organization. The new website architecture allows for future enhancements and efficient access to important information.

#### **Online Licensing**

In an effort for continuous development of processes that improve operations, productivity, and efficiencies, a primary goal of the OPLC in FY21 was to make all licensing available online. In December 2020, development began for allowing online renewal of licenses for

all Boards. In April of 2021, work was complete and all OPLC licensed professions were able to complete renewals of licenses online through the State of NH Egov portal and My License Office (MLO). Planning for initial licensing online was completed in May 2021 with work to begin in Fiscal Year 2022.

#### Communications

As a result of internal organizational changes, OPLC reviewed how it communicates with the public, professions, and Boards. This analysis resulted in many changes for improving communication and access to the OPLC. Initiatives included a complete rework of OPLC's phone directories for better access to the appropriate resources; standardization of email addresses; and, resource assignment, development, and implementation of email listings of licensees by professions with email mailing software that allows timely communications.

#### **Process Improvement**

Quality improvement and business redesign allowed the IT team to work closely with OPLC business units in the development of business and technical solutions that support continuous improvement of operations. These collaborative initiatives resulted in modifying systems that comply with OPLC operational needs while improving data and system integrity. Many board operational functions were able to be consolidated into OPLC organizational functions for improved productivity and efficiencies.

#### Board Collaboration and Public Access to the Boards

Throughout the COVID-19 New Hampshire State of Emergency, the OPLC was able to realize the benefits of online collaboration tools. Utilization of these tools continued beyond the State of Emergency providing the board members, professionals, and the public access to scheduled Board meetings, hearings, and events. OPLC Board rooms are now equipped with technology that can accommodate remote access and participation in board business. #### Planning for the Future

Many of the initiatives that were successful in FY21 provide a foundation for continuous improvement of OPLC operations and acquisition of appropriate business solutions. In FY22, plans are in place for the development and implementation of an Enforcement case management system, continued development of the OPLC online web presence, initial online licensing, and resources for supporting the Board partnerships.
