

Adopted Rules

We would like to inform you that the Board of Nursing Home Administrators has recently adopted rules, which will become effective June 22, 2024.

These rules relate to practice and procedure as noted below:

Nuh 200 regarding the process and procedures with hearings, declaratory rulings, rulemaking, statements of policy and interpretation, voluntary surrender of licenses, and initiating a waiver of a substantive rule upon its own motion by providing affected parties.

Nuh 305 regarding Emergency Permit, Petitions and Supervision. The adopted rules modify the requirements for a proposed acting Administrator including the permit be non-transferable and that the Administrator must meet the educational requirements outlined in Nuh 301.02. The facility should provide whether or not the proposed Administrator is currently in good standing as a licensed Registered Nurse in the State of New Hampshire, with at least one (1) years' experience working in a skilled nursing home setting.

The acting Administrator shall be supervised by a licensed Administrator. Any licensed Administrator about to become a supervisor of an acting Administrator shall meet the requirements of preceptor as defined in Nuh 102.06.

No licensed Administrator shall be permitted to supervise more than one acting Administrator at a time.

Please note that the rules currently in place are in effect until June 22, 2024, and must be adhered to until the new rules go into effect.
