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Checklist: MNA Reinstatement Application

Required items not submitted may cause delays in issuance of a license.

Reinstatement of a license is only applicable to licenses that have been expired for less than 365 days. If your license has been expired for longer than this duration, you will need to Apply for a New License.

Prerequisite

- ✓ Current NH LNA License
 - If LNA license is within 2 months of its expiration date, it must be renewed prior to applying for reinstatement of MNA licensure.

Required Information

- ✓ Reinstatement application
- ✓ Application fee as specified on our license fees page <u>here</u>
 - Application fees are non-refundable. To avoid a delay in licensure, please do not submit multiple applications.
- ✓ Continuing Education:
 - 8 of the 24 Continuing Education hours needed for LNA licensure must be related to medication, or;
 - Completed the MNA Education Program within 2 years of application date
